Day 1 - Sunday: Arrive in Prague

Day 1 - Sunday: Arrive in Venice

Arriving at Venice's airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure until you gather for a Welcome Dinner with your Tour Director and traveling companions. (**Dinner Included**)

Day 2 - Monday: In Venice

Then, visit the Academy of Fine Arts, where Michelangelo's David is displayed. The tour ends at the Piazzale Michelangelo with a spectacular view over Florence. The remainder of the day is yours to savor the Renaissance splendor of the Tuscan capital your own way. (**Breakfast & Dinner Included**)

Day 5 - Thursday: Florence to Assisi and Rome

Travel through the stunning panorama of Tuscany with its iconic landscapes as you make your way to Assisi, the hometown of St. Francis. Take a walking tour to see the main square and visit the impressive **Basilica of St. Francis**. Continue to Rome for dinner and an evening at leisure. (**Breakfast & Dinner Included**)

Day 6 - Friday: In Rome

A full-day sightseeing tour shows you all the highlights of the incomparable Eternal City. Visit the **Vatican Museums** with moving **Sistine Chapel** and grand **St. Peter's Basilica**. Day 1 - Saturday: Arrive in Madrid

You will be met and transferred to your hotel. The day is at leisure to begin exploring. Later, join your fellow travelers and your tour director for a welcome reception. (**Dinner Included**)

Day 2 - Sunday: In Madrid

We begin with a guided half-day city tour of Madrid. Our drive takes us through the Gran Vía and the Paseo de Castellana, past the Plaza de España, Plaza de Oriente, Plaza Mayor, Puerta del Sol, Atocha Station, the fountain of Neptune, Cibeles fountain, the Bullring, the Santiago Bernabeu soccer stadium, and many more. Day 3 - Monday: Excursion to Toledo

We visit Toledo, a city with a wealth of monuments. It is known as the “city of the three cultures” because Christians, Arabs and Jews lived there together for centuries. During our guided tour we visit the **Santo Tome Church** and the **Synagogue of Santa María**. From Toledo, we return to Madrid where the afternoon is at leisure. (**Breakfast Included**)

Day 4 - Tuesday: To Bilbao

We Depart for Bilbao. On the way, we stop in Burgos. Upon arrival S/S of Burgos with local guide including visit of the Cathedral. There is time for lunch on your own. From there, we continue to Bilbao where we have a **tasting of local tapas called pintxos**. (**Breakfast & Dinner Included**)

Day 5 - Wednesday: In Bilbao

On our visit to Bilbao, we see the vibrant old town with many shops, squares, and typical Basque tavernas. We enter the **Guggenheim Museum**, an architectural masterpiece designed by Frank Gehry. The collection includes large-scale and site-specific art by such contemporary artists as Jeff Koons and Willem de Kooning. The remainder of the day is free. (**Breakfast Included**)

Day 6 - Thursday: To Pamplona

After breakfast, we depart for San Sebastian. En route, we visit Getaria, a charming Basque coastal village. Upon arrival in San Sebastian, we see the Maria Cristina Hotel. It is here, at the Kursaal, that the film festival takes place. We also see La Concha beach, a crescent-shaped urban seaboard. In the afternoon we arrive in Pamplona. Dinner is served later that night. (**Breakfast & Dinner Included**)

Day 7 - Friday: To Barcelona

After breakfast, we have a half-day guided sightseeing tour of Pamplona featuring the Ciudadela, the City Walls, parks, and gardens. We will hear about the 'Running of the Bulls' race, part of the San Fermin festival. From Pamplona, we continue to Zaragoza for lunch on your own. Later that afternoon, we arrive in Barcelona and the rest of the day is at leisure. (**Breakfast Included**)

Day 8 - Saturday: In Barcelona

Our guided half-day sightseeing tour includes Barcelona's most important artistic sights: Gaudi's Batlló, Casa Milá, **Cathedral Sagrada Familia**, and Guell Park, declared an artistic monument and mankind's heritage by UNESCO. In the afternoon you are free to explore more on your own. Join your fellow travelers and your tour director for the farewell dinner. (**Breakfast Included**)

Itinerary

Day 1 - Saturday: Arrival in Lisbon

You will be met and transferred to your hotel. The day is at leisure to begin exploring on your own. Later, gather with your tour director and your fellow travelers for a welcome reception. (**Dinner Included**)

Day 2 - Sunday: Explore Lisbon

This morning we stroll through Baixa, Lisbon's historic heart and commercial center. We then drive to Belem to view Belem Tower and the Discovery Monument. The Vasco de Gama tomb in the Jeronimos Monastery is next on our journey. After our tour, enjoy beautiful streets of Lisbon on own. The evening is at leisure. (**Breakfast Included**)

Day 3 - Monday: Lisbon with Excursion to Sintra, Cabo Da Roca, Cascais, and Estoril

This morning we depart on a half-day private sightseeing tour to Sintra, Cascais, Estoril, and Cabo da Roca. Sintra boasts a historic Centre that is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. After our visit to the **Sintra National Palace**, we continue to Cabo da Roca, the westernmost cape in Continental Europe. Thereafter, we travel to Cascais, a picturesque fishing town with some quirky museums, beautiful gardens, and a lively fish market. Then we're off to Estoril, a former fishing town turned cosmopolitan destination for well-heeled travelers. We return to Lisbon early in the afternoon. Rest of the day at leisure. (**Breakfast Included**)

Day 4 - Tuesday: Fatima

After breakfast, we leave Lisbon and depart towards the north. Our first destination is Obidos, a charming village of white houses on a hill, surrounded by fourteenth century's walls. Here we stop for a **tasting of cherry liquor**. We proceed to Nazare after the tasting. Nazare is a popular tourist attraction and picturesque village located on the Atlantic coast. Our next stop is the Monastery of Batalha, a Dominican Convent. We finish the day in Fatima, a Catholic pilgrimage destination and home to sacred sites and religious artifacts. **(Breakfast Included)**

Day 5 - Wednesday: Coimbra

In the morning, we travel to Tomar for a half-day sightseeing tour and visit the **Luso-Hebrew Museum**. We then proceed towards Buçaco to visit the famous Buçaco Forest and for an outside view of Buçaco Palace. In Coimbra, our half-day sightseeing tour includes a visit to the **University and Library**. **(Breakfast Included)**

Day 6 - Thursday: Porto

We continue to Aveiro and Costa Nova for an orientation tour and then travel through the Douro Valley, classified by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. Traditionally, the wines from this region were transported down-river in flat-bottomed boats called "rabelos". The wine was stored in barrels in cellars of the Vila Nova de Gaia, just across the river from Porto. After our **lunch with wine tasting** in the Douro Valley, we continue to Porto. **(Breakfast & Lunch Included)**

Day 7 - Friday: Explore Porto

During our half-day sightseeing tour of Porto, we visit the **Palacio de Bolsa** (the stock exchange palace) and end our tour in one of the famous wine cellars where we have another **tasting**. After this, we continue with a **boat excursion**, one of the most spectacular experiences in the city. Our afternoon is free, at leisure. In the evening gather with your fellow travelers and your tour director for our farewell dinner. **(Breakfast & Dinner Included)**

Day 8 - Saturday: Depart Porto

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport for your departure flight. **(Breakfast Included)**





Amazing Norway

8 days from Oslo to Lillehammer, Kristiansund, and Bergen

Itinerary

Day 1 - Sunday: Arrival in Oslo

Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is free. Meet your fellow travelers tonight at Welcome reception. Overnight. **(Dinner Included)**

Day 2 - Monday: Oslo to Lillehammer

This morning we begin our tour of the Norwegian capital, passing through the central area with the Cathedral, Parliament, main street Karl Johan, University and Royal Palace with a walk in the impressive Vigeland park with its more than two hundred incredible sculptures. Afterwards, drive to Lillehammer, famous for the organization of the Winter Olympic Games in 1994. The clean air, varied landscapes, cultural events, museums with different themes such as the Art Museum, the Automobile Museum, and the Olympic Museum, make Lillehammer a city of culture, exhibitions, and festivals. Explore the old center with its wooden houses dating back to the 19th century and the main pedestrian street, Storgata. Dinner and overnight. **(Breakfast & Dinner Included)**

Day 3 - Tuesday: Lillehammer, Molde/ Kristiansund

Breakfast at hotel. Today we drive through Peer Gynt Road with a stop for walking to admire different views for this wonderful national park. Then continue via Romsdal Valley part of the Golden Route then, highly appreciated by climbing enthusiasts. We cross by ferry from Solnes to Afarnes and quick stop in Kristiansund. We continue the tour as we admire the fantastic piece of engineering which is "The Atlantic Road", from Kårvåg to Vevang, stopping at the village of Bud, before arriving the hotel. **(Breakfast Included)**

Day 4 - Wednesday: Molde/Kristiansund

After breakfast, we board a ferry to Vestnes and from there enjoy the scenic ride; winding along the narrow slopes of the mountain, bordered by stone railings, the Trollstigen-Trolls Road opened in 1936 and is a testimony to the extraordinary engineering and construction skills of its time. The journey continues through the alpine landscape with glacial lakes, and glaciers. We will cross the Norddalsfjord from Linge to Eidsdal, after which we follow the Eagle's Road, an incredible winding sequence that will give us spectacular views of the Geirangerfjord, often described as the most beautiful fjord in all of Norway. The landscapes are included in UNESCO World Natural Heritage. We continue to the Nordfjord for dinner and overnight **(Breakfast & Dinner Included)**

Day 5 - Thursday: Nordfjord to Bergen

Today, our journey will take us to the Fjærland area where we admire the most spectacular the Jostedalsbreen glacier, namely the Boyabreen by Fjærland. We continue towards the longest and deepest fjord in Norway, the second largest in the world, Sognefjord, the King's Fjord. 


